# Spring Home Maintenance Tips/Ideas:

- 1. Home Exterior Inspection for Maintenance Issues
  - Missing or damaged shingles
  - o Clogged gutters or downspouts
  - o Masonry/Concrete/Foundation cracks
  - Exposed surfaces accessible to water or insects
  - Damage to door or window seals
- 2. Yard & Outdoor Living Preparation
  - Lawn tool maintenance and preparation
  - Remove remaining fall and winter debris
  - Sprinkler system activation/maintenance
  - Spring lawn and garden care
  - Deck and patio cleaning/maintenance
  - o Clean the grill
- 3. Interior Cleaning and Maintenance
  - Spring cleaning
  - Replace smoke detector batteries
  - Test/service air conditioning units
  - Check your washer and dryer for fire hazards

## Homeowner Bylaw Note:

- All homes and properties should exhibit regular and ongoing maintenance as well as the timely repair of exterior walls, siding, fascia boards, garage doors, windows, exterior window trim, brickwork, and roofs.
- All homes and properties should be free of any and all visible signs of rubbish, trash, construction materials and refuse of any kind.
- Homeowners backing up to 79th Street, 83rd Street and Pflumm are responsible for mowing from their property line to the street.
