Post Oak Farm Residents -

We are reaching the end of our fiscal year and it is time to review the activities for the year. Some of the goals set as priorities for this summer are almost complete. I don't know how many of you have had the opportunity to look at the Swimming Pool House this season, but the structure is rebuilt and the painting and trimming are in the final stages.

The pool parking lot will receive a cleaning and resurface application after the closing of the pool this season. The kiddie pool will also receive it's own resurfacing by Mid America Pools at no cost to Post Oak Farms.

Post Oak Farm pool was visited by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission and it was discovered that the drain covers and the safety emergency power cut off was not in compliance with the new regulations. The pool was closed for almost a week while we obtained, installed and tested the new equipment. The funds needed were available in the pool management budget.

Some of the trees in the pool area had to be removed to assure the safety of our residents. It appears the injections administered last Fall in an attempt to save the Bradford Pear trees in the common area were not effective. We are currently obtaining bids for the removal of the diseased trees. The board would welcome suggestions as to what type of trees should be planted to replace them.

The persistent effort to catch up with delinquent dues has been rewarding, resulting in more residents sharing the burden of up keep which, in turn, helps keep our property values stable.

We are changing the format for the annual meeting in an attempt to gain more resident participation. The Social Committee is preparing a Chile Cook-off Contest to follow the annual meeting. The business meeting will be brief and I will, at that time, introduce your new board President, Eric Smith.

As you all know, it takes time and effort to make sure our neighborhood continues to be a pleasant and safe place to live while keeping our properties appealing and the value of our homes intact. We must depend on the time and skills of community volunteers.

If any of you have a couple of hours to spare and are willing to serve in any way, please contact Eric or your area director. Your participation is sorely needed and would be appreciated.

With that being said, I want to thank the board, the committees, the volunteers and the pool management company for their efforts in assisting me during my term as the POFHOA President.
