

Skimmer: Last year when they were doing the pressure test, we found out that the skimmer closest to the wading pool was not level which means it is not working properly. It was voted on and approved to get the skimmer leveled, and fixed.

Concrete Slabs: We have a very weathered and cracking slab on the Northwest side of the Pool. It was voted on and approved to replace the entire slab in that section.
