

Bradford Pear Trees

We have several Bradford Pear trees in the neighborhood and on the west side of the pool fence. We noticed on the pool trees that several leaves are turning brown. We contacted two arborist and they found it was Fire Blight. This is bacteria and has to be treated with an antibiotic injection for a minimum of 3 years. In order to save these trees we had them treated and pruned. We will also place mulch around them to retain moisture.

This bacteria becomes prevalent when trees are under heat stress and lack of moisture for long periods of time. The weather condition for the past two years has been the cause of these problems.

You may want to check out your trees. They suggest deep root watering, good air flow through the trees and 2" mulch in a 6-8' circle around the tree to help prevent this disease. It may not prevent the problem but it helps the heath of the tree.
