



Due to the COVID-19 virus, a decision needed to be made to extend the dues deadline. An email “meeting” with the board of directors and officers was in order.

President Jacob Russell sent a reminder to our neighbors about the deadline of March 31, 2020 for paying dues. Here is part of his email sent to our neighborhood March 23, 2020 at 4:02 PM.

“I hope you are all finding peace in this difficult time. As the impact of COVID-19 has increased the past couple of weeks, I am sure each of you is facing a unique set of trials.”

Because of the COVID-19 virus pandemic, our president had an online “meeting.” Here is part of the note he sent to the board of directors.

“Upon further discussion with Jen, we are financially able to push back dues until May 1st - giving an extra month for those most affected by the pandemic. She does not have financial concern with this decision given the circumstances. Currently, 133 residents have paid, giving us about \$40,000 right now - about \$23,000 is outstanding.

Before announcing this, I will need the board's approval. Would you please respond with your thoughts and/or vote for pushing the dues deadline back to May 1st?”

Votes to move the deadline:

- Area 3: Laure Long - Yes
- Area 4: Scott Adams - Yes
- Area 5: Denise Judson - Yes

The decision was made to push back dues to May 1, 2020.

Jacob sent a note to the neighborhood March 26, 2020 at 3:52 PM

“After much deliberation between our treasurer, the board, and me, we have determined that we will be able to extend the deadline for dues to MAY 1, 2020. Dues payed after May 1st will have an 8% interest for a late payment.

We understand that the economic impact of COVID-19 and the resulting response has been very difficult for many of the families in our community. With the home-order and unemployment increase in the past few days, we want to respond with grace and understanding to our neighbors impacted the most. That being said, we hope this shifted deadline will be of benefit to the families in our neighborhood.
